

## Christmas Paper Bag Carollers

### SEARCH TERMS:

### Materials:

- 11901 - Small Paper Gift Bag - Brown - 11 x 14 x 6cm
- 10364 - CleverPatch Junior PVA Glue - 250ml
- 10897 - Student Scissors - Pack of 20
- 13652 - CleverPatch Cover Paper Assorted - A4 - Pack of 275
- 16531 - CleverPatch Triangular Maxi Permanent Markers - Black - Pack of 12



# How to:

## STEP 1

Draw and cut a rectangle, 15cm x 11cm from craft paper. Measure where the handle on the bag is located and cut slits in the paper so that the paper can slide over the handles. Attach with glue.

## STEP 2

Draw and cut an oval, roughly 8cm x 5cm out of white cover paper. This will be your singer's face. Attach to the top of your paper bag just below the handle. Draw and cut out some hair for your singer. Look to our designs above for inspiration.

## STEP 3

Draw and cut out two rectangles, 7cm x 3cm out of craft paper to make arms. Draw and cut two gloves from cover paper, use the arms as a size guide. Glue the gloves to the ends of the arms. Fold the opposite end of the arm, 3cm from the end.

## STEP 4

Draw and cut a rectangle, 8cm x 6cm from white cover paper to make a book. Fold the paper in half and draw a music note on the front cover with a marker. Glue the ends of the gloves to the book. Use glue to attach the arms to the paper bag at the fold you made.

## STEP 5

Cut a small oval out of red cover paper and glue to the singer's face to make a mouth. Use a marker to draw on eyes.
