SEARCH TERMS:

Materials:

- 10036 - Cardboard Squares - Assorted - Pack of 100
- 10816 - Wiggle Eyes Black - 1.5cm - Pack of 100
- 12854 - Paper Cups - Pack of 100
- 10364 - CleverPatch Junior PVA Glue - 250ml
- 10897 - Student Scissors - Pack of 20
- 15800 - CleverPatch Junior Artist Paint - 500ml - Set of 11 colours



How to:

TIP

Alternatively you can use CleverPatch™ Markers & blue CleverPatch™ Cover Paper instead of paint and paper strips for this activity.



STEP 1

Paint your cup blue. Allow to dry.

STEP 2

Draw a whale tail shape on white cardboard. Paint the tail blue to match the whale body.

STEP 3

Cut four strips of blue cardboard to make a waterspout. Curl one end of each strip around the end of a pencil to make a curve and tape the ends together.

STEP 4

Attach the waterspout to the top of your whale with tape.

STEP 5

Add some large wiggle eyes to the front. Attach with glue.

STEP 6

Attach your whale tail to the back of the cup by taping the end to the inside of your cup (so that the tail sits flat).
