### Materials:

- 10238 - Metallic Yarn - Gold - 20g
- 11743 - Watercolor Magic Glitter Liquid Watercolour - Magenta - 225ml
- 12378 - Embroidery Thread - Pink - 48m
- 12931 - Paper Lantern
- 13681 -
- 10448 - EC Glitter Paint - Fairy Krystal - 500ml
- 10708 - Round Paint Brushes - Assorted - Pack of 30
- 10897 - Student Scissors - Pack of 20
- 15800 - CleverPatch Junior Artist Paint - 500ml - Set of 11 colours



# How to:

## STEP 1

Begin by painting a floral pattern onto your lantern. Use the wooden end of a paint brush to dot the colour on. Use red and pink paint for petals, and yellow for the flower's centre. Allow to dry.

## STEP 2

Mix together magenta glitter paint with fairy krystal glitter paint.

## STEP 3

Gently paint over the lantern with your glitter paint mix. This will create a pink wash and add a touch of sparkle.

## STEP 4

Thread beads onto embroidery thread and tie these to the bottom of the lantern.

## STEP 5

Thread gold yarn through the top of the lantern and tie the loose ends into a knot to secure. Paper lanterns make great hanging decorations!
