

3D Wooden Soldier

Materials:

- 10040 - Corrugated Foil Board - Pack of 20
- 10814 - Wiggle Eyes - Black Assortment - Tub of 560
- 11126 - Cup Sequins - Multi - 50g Pack
- 12008 - Soft Yarn Wool - Black - 100g
- 13271 - 3D Wooden People - Pack of 20
- 17539 - Felt Sheets - Black - Pack of 10
- 10189 - Crayola Washable SuperTips Markers Deskpack - Pack of 40
- 10364 - CleverPatch Junior PVA Glue - 250ml
- 10708 - Round Paint Brushes - Assorted - Pack of 30
- 10897 - Student Scissors - Pack of 20
- 13652 - CleverPatch Cover Paper Assorted - A4 - Pack of 275
- 15800 - CleverPatch Junior Artist Paint - 500ml - Set of 11 colours



How to:

TIP

To get started, download the template above.



STEP 1

Paint the head and hands of your 3D Wooden Person in a skin tone colour. Paint the shoes black and allow to dry.

STEP 2

Using the templates provided cut out your soldier's uniform and hat. We used green BRENEX paper for his hat, jacket, collar and pants. We chose brown BRENEX paper for his shirt and hat band. Finally we used black felt for his belt.

STEP 3

Using coloured markers, colour 4 strips on the white paper (0.5 x 1cm) to create the medallion ribbons. Cut a small square (0.5 x 0.5cm) of corrugated board.

STEP 4

Use glue to attach the board to the soldier's hat to create a badge. Use glue to attach all of the clothing items to your wooden soldier. Attach the clothes in the following order: pants, shirt, jacket, right/left collar, belt, hat and hat band.

STEP 5

Add sequins to create buttons and medallions. Attach with glue.

STEP 6

Cut a piece of black yarn (9cm). Use glue to attach the yarn to your soldier's face, creating a strap for his hat.

STEP 7

Finally, attach wiggle eyes with glue and use a marker to draw on a nose and mouth
