Materials:

12671 - Paper Pad - Blue - 120 pages

10897 - Student Scissors - Pack of 20

16531 - CleverPatch Triangular Maxi Permanent Markers - Black - Pack of 12



How to:

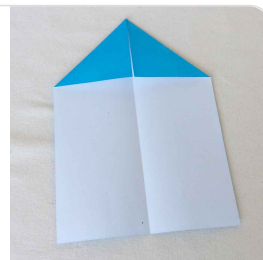
STEP 1

Begin by folding your piece of paper in half length ways. Unfold the paper.



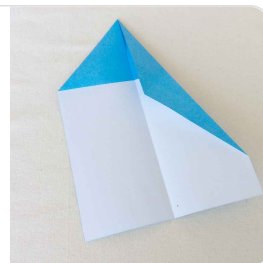
STEP 2

Flip the paper over and fold the top two corners in towards the fold in the paper.



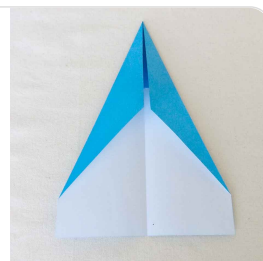
STEP 3

Fold the paper in half length ways again. Your folded paper should now have a pointed tip. Open the paper back up.



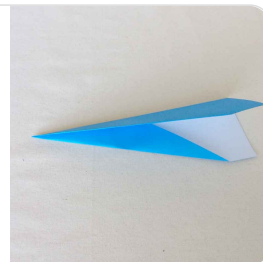
STEP 4

Fold the pointed end of the paper in towards the fold at the centre again.



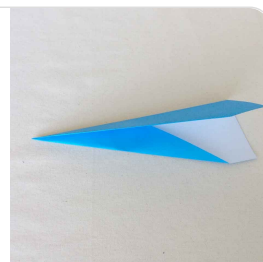
STEP 5

Repeat the step above with the other side of the paper.



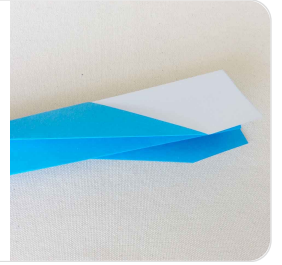
STEP 6

Fold the paper in half at the centre fold again.



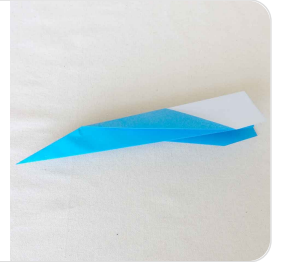
STEP 7

Create a wing by folding the square end of the paper down on itself.



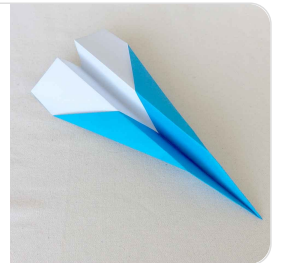
STEP 8

Repeat the step above with the paper on the other side of the fold. You should now have two wings.



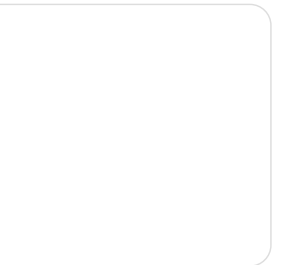
STEP 9

Flatten the fold in the centre and wings so it becomes crisp and flat.



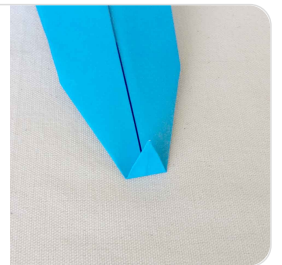
STEP 10

Open up the wings so they stand up.



STEP 11

Fold the front tip of your aeroplane up to create a wind breaker.



TIP

Don't forget to put a paperclip on the tip of your plane to give it some weight!



STEP 12

Decorate your plane with coloured paper.
