

Plaster Pencil Holder

Search terms: plaster of paris, pencils, paper cup.

SEARCH TERMS: plaster of paris, pencils, paper cup

Materials:

11085 - Paper Cups - Pack of 20

12357 - Plaster of Paris - 1.8kg Pack



How to:

STEP 1

Mix up an amount of plaster according to the instructions provided.

STEP 2

Fill your paper cups to about half full with the plaster and bump any air bubbles out by gently tapping the cup onto the table.



STEP 3

Allow the plaster to set for a minute or so depending on how thick you made it and then carefully push 3 fat pencils into the plaster making sure you do not hit the bottom of the cup.



TIP

If the holes start closing over push the pencils back in for a little bit longer.



STEP 4

Leave the pencils in for a minute or so and then once the plaster is set enough, turn the pencils around as you carefully pull them out.



STEP 5

Allow the plaster to set for at least 24 hours and then carefully tear the paper cup off.



STEP 6

Decorate with paint and your gorgeous gift is ready to give!
