

## Watercolour Discovery

This is a great activity for colour exploration. Use the 3 primary colours for a simple colour lesson or add a variety of secondary colours for a more complex experiment!

*Search terms: fun with paint, exploratory play, science, colours, light tray*

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### Materials:

10017 - Plastic Teaspoons - Pack of 100

10699 - Paint Pipettes - Pack of 12

14924 - Ultra Bright LED Light Panel - A3

16366 -

16620 - CleverPatch Exploration Light Tray



## How to:

### TIP

It may be useful to place a splash mat under the work surface to catch any excess paint.



### STEP 1

Place your light panel onto the work surface.

### TIP

Make sure the cord is not a trip hazard.



### STEP 2

Place your tray on top of your light panel and plug it into the power point. Turn your light panel on.

### STEP 3

Carefully squeeze lines and spots of watercolour onto your tray.



### STEP 4

Using either end of a plastic spoon, spread the watercolours around the tray. Observe what happens to the colours as they meet and mix with each other.
