

## Hessian Boutonniere

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Description: This buttonhole is perfect for a country themed wedding. Make one for your groom and each of your groomsmen. Best of all your flowers will stay fresh on your special day!

Search terms: *buttonhole, corsage, vintage wedding.*

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### Materials:

- 10230 - Beading Wire - Silver - 22 Metres
- 10843 - Self-Adhesive Brooch Backs - Pack of 25
- 11096 - Calico - 80 x 100cm
- 11151 - Satin Ribbon - White - 25 Metres
- 11802 - Toothpicks - Pack of 200
- 12406 - Hessian Sheets - Natural - Pack of 10
- 13739 - Bead Bumper Box
- 14037 - Jute Twine - Thin - 70 Metres
- 12505 - CleverPatch Glue Gun Starter Set



## How to:

### STEP 1

Cut a long piece of white calico. Fold in half lengthways. Thread a toothpick into the middle of your calico.

### STEP 2

Create your rose by wrapping the material around and pinching in place.

### STEP 3

Use twine to tie your rose in place. Trim any excess material.

### STEP 4

Thread a bead onto a long piece of beading wire. Fold your wire back over itself and twist together.

### STEP 5

Repeat until you have three beads on twisted wire. Group the wire together and twist to secure all three together.

### STEP 6

Cut two hessian leaves. One slightly bigger than the other.

### STEP 7

Layer your leaves, rose, and beads together.

### STEP 8

Wrap your leaves around your rose. Secure in place with hot glue.

### STEP 9

Wrap a piece of ribbon around the stem of your flower and secure in place with glue.

### STEP 10

Attach a brooch back to hang your boutonniere. Use hot glue for permanent adhesion.
