

## Dolly Peg Simpson's Donkey

This Dolly Peg Donkey Idea encourages us to remember, honour and assist children to talk about John Simpson Kirkpatrick and his famous Donkey during the First World War. This activity works best when you use a hot glue gun. You may need an adults help.

### Materials:

- 10851 - Dolly Pegs - Natural - Pack of 24
- 12008 - Soft Yarn Wool - Black - 100g
- 12149 - Wooden Spools - Natural - Pack of 72
- 16476 - Wiggle Eyes Black - 0.5cm - Pack of 100
- 18535 - Christmas Felt - Pack of 40
- 11995 - CleverPatch Junior Artist Paint - White - 500ml
- 15799 - CleverPatch Junior Artist Paint - Black - 500ml
- 15800 - CleverPatch Junior Artist Paint - 500ml - Set of 11 colours



## How to:

### TIP

Please note: When using a hot glue gun you will require adult assistance and supervision.



### STEP 1

Collect a spool and 3 dolly pegs. Arrange your dolly pegs to create legs and ears for your donkey. Attach with glue. Allow to dry.

### STEP 2

Paint your donkey grey with black hooves. Allow to dry.

### STEP 3

Cut a small rectangle of red felt to create a blanket large enough to cover your donkey's spool body. You may like to fringe it with a pair of scissors. Cut a small cross from white felt.

### STEP 4

Attach your blanket and cross to your donkey's body with glue. Allow to dry.

### STEP 5

Cut a small headband and cross for your donkey from red and white felt.

## STEP 6

Use glue to attach your headband, 2 wiggle eyes and a tail made from wool to your donkey. Allow to dry.

## STEP 7

Lastly, use a marker to add nostrils to your donkey.
