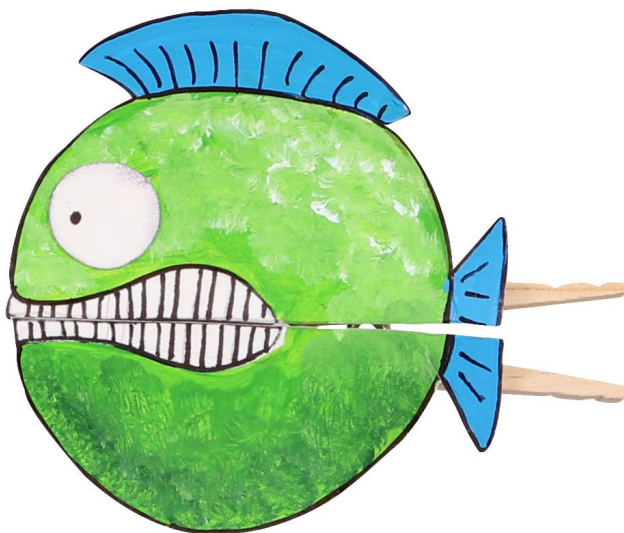




'Piranhas Don't Eat Bananas' Peg Piranha

1 x Wooden Pegs - Natural **13520** Pack of 24

1 x CleverPatch Cover Paper - White **16154** A4 - Pack of 25

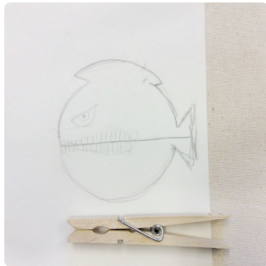
1 x CleverPatch Acrylic Paint Tube - Light Green 16880 75ml

1 x CleverPatch Acrylic Paint Tube - Light Blue 16881 75ml

1 x CleverPatch Acrylic Paint Tube - White 16886 75ml

1 x CleverPatch Acrylic Paint Tube - Dark Green 16913 75ml

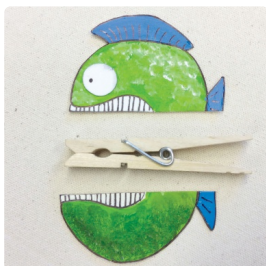
How to



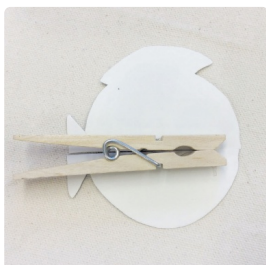
1 Print off the piranha template provided.



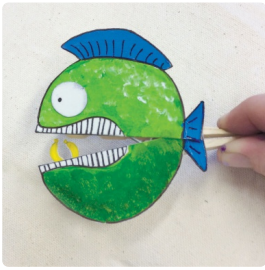
2 Bring your piranha to life using coloured paint and a fine tip marker. Allow to dry.



3 Once dry, carefully cut out your piranha. You should have 2 pieces.



4 Glue the pieces to each side of the peg and allow to dry.

Test out your piranha to make sure his chomping mouth opens and shuts.
