



To make the ant's legs cut 6 pieces of chenille stems.
Bend them at right angles in the centre of the chenille stem.
Attach to the body with glue.







 Use a black marker to draw the stripes onto your bee.






To make whiskers for your cat cut 2 pieces of chenille stem. Cross the pieces over each other and attach to your cat's nose with glue.
















To create a curly tail wrap a pink chenille stem around your finger. Slightly pull it out and attach to your pig's body with glue.







To create a feather for the top of your quail's head wrap one end of a chenille stem around your finger. Attach the straight end to your quail's head with glue.
















• To create tentacles cut chenille stems into short pieces (depending on the size of the urchin). Attach the tentacles to the urchin with glue.









• To create a spine cut a white chenille stem to fit the 'X'. Cut 7 smaller pieces of white chenille stem for the bones and place them across the spine. Attach with glue.
