All About The Farm

These Blackline Masters can be completed in a variety of ways. The activities are designed to be stimulating, crafty and fun! They range from simple colouring to more complex artworks depending on your requirements – it's up to you! They will equip children with important skills like colouring, cutting, gluing, folding, constructing and creative thinking. Below are some hints and tips for each activity to help you get the most out of your Blackline Masters.

All About the Farm Blackline Masters have been designed to take you on a fun and crafty exploration! With a range of activities students are able to learn about animals you might encounter on a farm in a fun and creative way. Students can work individually or as part of a group. Experiment with materials and art techniques.

Stand Up Farm Animals

Scissors and glue will be required to complete this activity. For best results, copy the Blackline Master onto cover paper. Ask students to colour and decorate their farm animals and cut them out. To construct the horse, fold along the dotted lines in between the 2 body halves. Fold the body halves up and join together at the top with a small amount of glue or tape. Do the same to make the other farm animals. These cute farm animals make great additions to the Construct-a-Barn. Remember these sheets can be enlarged or reduced on a photocopier according to your requirements.

Construct-a-Barn

Scissors and glue will be required to complete this activity. For best results, copy the Blackline Master onto cover paper. Ask students to colour and decorate their barn. Alternatively copy the Blackline Master onto coloured cover paper. Cut out the barn and fold along all the grey dotted lines. Using the tabs, glue the barn together. The Construct-a-Barn can be used with the Stand Up Farm Animals to make a farm scene. Remember these sheets can be enlarged or reduced on a photocopier according to your requirements.

Farm Animal Dice

Scissors and glue will be required to complete this activity. For best results, copy the Blackline Master onto cover paper. Ask students to colour and decorate their dice. Cut out the dice and fold along all the grey dotted lines. Using the tabs, glue the dice together. Have students sit in a circle and roll their Farm Animal Dice, students can then talk about specific farm animals according to what animal has been rolled.

Farm Landscape

Ask students to colour and decorate their sheet for a quick and easy craft activity. Have students draw their favourite farm animals on the landscape. Remember these sheets can be enlarged or reduced on a photocopier according to your requirements. You could make a large A3 poster for group decorating.

Sheep Story

After researching sheep on farms, have students write a short story or poem about a sheep. Once complete, students can decorate around the sheep story with collage materials eg. cotton wool balls.

Fun on the Farm Activity Book

Scissors will be required to complete this activity. For best results, copy the Blackline Master onto cover paper. Ask students to cut out the sheet and fold along the dotted lines to create their booklet. Ask the students to colour and decorate their Activity Book and finish by completing the puzzles.

Farm Animals

Ask students to colour and decorate their farm animal sheet for a quick and easy craft activity. Remember these sheets can be enlarged or reduced on a photocopier according to your requirements. You could even photocopy onto a plastic sheet and project (with overhead projector) the animals onto display paper fixed to a wall for students to trace and do a large scale farm animal painting!

Farm Match-Ups


Discuss with students different animals and what they can be used for on a farm. Scissors will be required to complete this activity. For best results, copy the Blackline Master onto cover paper. Ask students to colour and decorate their farm match-ups sheet. Have students cut out the farm cards and then cut them in half following the dotted lines. Ask students to mix up their farm cards and then try to match them up again.


Learn to Draw a Horse




Scarecrow Colouring Sheet


